What is FND?

FND is a problem with the functioning of the nervous system. It is the brain's inability to send and receive messages properly. Many different risk factors can contribute to the development of the disorder. FND can affect men, women, and children.

FND is the second most common reason for an outpatient neurology visit. It produces disability and impairment of quality of life that is similar to that seen in people with Parkinson's or Epilepsy.
